rtists have long been captivated by the rhythm of oceans slowly meeting sand, the dramatic plumes of white crashing against boulders, the relaxing calm of sandy beaches, the acrophobic feeling of standing on a high sand dune, or the mesmerizing light crossing a lake.


John Marin (1870-1953) responded with abstract patterns of lines and shapes; William Trost Richards (1833-1905) painted every detail of the water reaching Newport, Rhode Island; and Winslow Homer (1836-1910) suggested the threatening power of ocean waves.

Clearly such shoreline landscapes, whether at the edge of a pond or the Pacific Ocean, were just as much a source of inspiration for artists of the past as they are for painters today. Here is a sample of paintings in oil, watercolor, and pastel by contemporary artists who gather most of their visual information outdoors while they are working directly from nature.



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




